- www.smore.com

- Like a newsletter, but can be connected as website
- One page
- Customizable backgrounds
- Share on social media
- View analytics to see how many visitors you have
- Add titles, text, pictures, events, bio info, web links, and audio/video links
- Parents/students can follow your page and be notified when it is updated.
- **Drawback:** You cannot upload documents to this format, must save images to your computer before you can upload to your page

- Another newsletter-like option
- One page
- Embedded image search
- Share on social media
- Limited backgrounds, or you can upload a photo background
- Add titles, text, images, movie and audio clips, web links, buttons, maps, embedded contact forms, PowerPoints (uploaded to SlideShare), Twitter feed, etc.
- Drawback: You cannot upload documents to this format, very basic

- Full webpage capabilities!
- Can link to multiple pages, formatted by template
- Can add titles, text, images, image galleries, image slideshows, maps, contact forms, assignment drops, embed codes, dividers, buttons, YouTube videos, documents, flash files, block quotes, polls, social icons, RSVP forms, surveys, bookings, forums.
- You can post assignments and documents on your webpage and have students submit their homework right there on your site!!!
- Professional looking templates

- Full webpage capabilities
- Can link to multiple pages
- Not as visually pleasing as Weebly
- Very interactive can post notes, assignments, files, etc.
